



NOTICE OF WORKSHOP REGARDING VGS's PROPOSED INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN

VGS's proposed 2024 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) provides a plan for meeting customers' current and future energy needs safely and affordably while addressing the urgent challenges and economic costs of climate change. The proposed IRP was filed in January 2024 and is currently being reviewed by the Public Utility Commission and Department of Public Service in Case No. 24-0125-PET.
