- Rebates increased to 75% of project costs, up to \$10,000

These rebates can be combined with 0% APR financing—up to \$20,000 over 5 years—through our partner, Green Mountain Credit Union.

Income eligibility is based on household income relative to county median income levels.

If you smell or suspect a leak, move to a safe environment, do not switch on any lights or appliances, leave your doors open as you exit the building, and immediately call 911.
